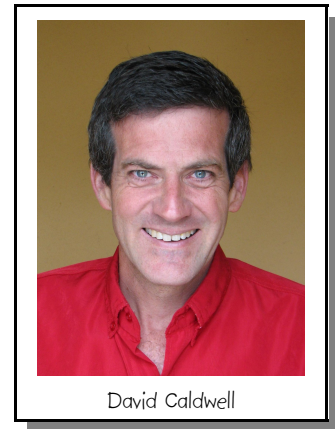
Volunteer Opportunities In Camp Experiences
