Loma Kids

Background: Accessible by public bus twice a day, Loma Caliente is a ranching community of about 40 homes. Loma hosts horses and pickup trucks, sawmills, three home fronts to buy soda and candy, a limited elementary school, a Catholic church and a soccer field. The community has electricity. Water comes from the surrounding hills and is excellent in quality.

Need: Share words and actions of Jesus to those in Loma.

Task: As a visiting group, formulate a plan to interact with the Loma youth in such a way as to open the Gospel to them. Share your abilities with the Loma community.

Ideas:

- Present a mime in Loma.
- Teach English.
- Invite kids to Los Domos after a soccer game.
- Share food and testimonies.
- Sit close, eat popcorn and watch the Jesus Video, etc. together. (Bring the DVD and a projector.)
- Have an afternoon planned for water activities in the reservoir. (The camp has 4 kayaks.)
- Program a VBS using the camp activities at Los Domos.
- Present a set of science demonstrations that connect God's marvelous creation and Christ the creator.
