After a couple of months of intense preparation, we hosted the Mexico Christian Camping International regional conference. The 40 participants enjoyed the outdoor atmosphere of Los Domos and fabulous traditional foods prepared from scratch by our camp cooks (who are also our neighbors). Two additional bathrooms were functional. A new design to replace rotting wood tables, the Geo-Table, was in place and used greatly. The grounds were in top shape.

One of the evenings, David was asked to share about how our lakeside camp in the mountains came about. "David, seeing all that enthusiasm when you spoke, all that love, that passion, really encourages me to keep going, to choose God and His service before anything else." - Luis Rodriguez

As a special treat, we were privileged to have our first RYCCA camp cook, Ale, (who is also a board member) visiting with us as well, so David asked her to share her story.

Ale began working with us 17 years ago when her baby, Grecia, was just four months old (pictured above with David, her "abuelito"). Ale joined us as we began to clear the land. She helped me (Karen) cook for our first group of 35 counselors, when we lived in tents and cooked over campfires. We reminisced about the first morning of her first camp, how the rains came down so heavily that it washed out our temporary kitchen even before we could cook breakfast.

Ale shared that the most impacting experience she had during camp was when the rains were headed toward the campsite yet again, and I prayed for them to not touch our area. She recounted her vivid memory of how she could see the storm all around but just in the few acres of the camp space there was no rain.

The power of God was evident and it changed her life.

We continue to work with the young couple who are training to be missionaries to India, Luis and Cynthia. Each week we practice English together to keep Luis learning and growing in the language. 
## **Summer Preparations**
