
Teaching Artisan's Workshop Training | Spring 2019

There was laughing and shouting as they hit the volleyball back and forth over the net and played ga-ga ball. Then they got the kayaks and went for a fun paddle on the lake. We love this family and are praying that God would touch each of their hearts so that they might know Him personally.
