Training | Spring, 2021

Camps here in Mexico have been affected by restrictions, but not as you might think. Numbers, yes have been reduced for now. But perhaps strategically, numbers of kids that will go to camp have potentially increased. In January and April, we had intense training for a handful of potential camp directors. These never-before directors will in turn train their own counselors from their own churches and host their own camps with their own kids. The next directors training is to be in July. One small camp has already been realized in the state of Hidalgo. So far people from five states have participated.

In a related matter, **the new directors need a source of material for training their counselors.** So David is developing a counselor training website using software developed by Wycliffe that facilitates multilingual presentations.

One Year Later | March 23, 2021


