The trumpet sounds over the mountains veiled in early darkness. Another morning where people interested in youth are being challenged to think differently about what their ministry could be. David plays Reveille, and the July Synergistic Camps event progresses: homework, notes, summaries,

planning, review, role playing, challenging existing philosophies and creating new ones, scheduling, building new camp organizations. This is the third such event of 2021.

After a quick illustration of thermodynamics by pointing out that the tea inside a thermos on the table was not hotter from when it was put in the day before, Miguel profoundly remarked "It's illogical!" His statement was directed at the type of evolution that removes God from the equation of creation. Miguel's team would be involved in designing a camp theme that would address the very important topic of "Our image in Christ." Each secession of new directors sees this as critical need for the youth with whom they are involved. A main concept of that particular workshop hour was that we as Christian leaders need to take the time to understand strategies that the world is using to erode minds from believing in God. Understand the problem and we can then synergistically use God's Word, prayer, and intentional preparation to lovingly communicate God's wisdom.

The next event for training new camp directors is planned for January 10-15, 2022.


Discipleship | 2009 - 2021


